

## Couples Questions

Complete these on your own time, when you have a quiet moment to be alone with yourself. Please, don't share your answers with your partner before the ceremony. These are intended for me to better understand your ceremony goals and relationship history.

1. How did you meet? What is your story?
2. Why do you two "work"?
3. How do you envision your life together? Goals, dreams, passions?
4. What makes your partner amazing? Think big, little, serious, silly, it's all on the table?
5. What are your biggest relationship challenges?
6. Does your ceremony have significant importance to someone else in your families? Mom, grandmother, father, you?
7. Is there anything else you want to tell me or think would be helpful for me to know, to help create the best wedding experience possible?



## Ceremony Logistics/Questions

The answers to these questions will help shape the feel and content of your ceremony, as well as understand your expectations.

[Only one of you needs to answer these, but, feel free to work together on them]

1. Do you want your ceremony to be traditional and formal? Are we incorporating either of your faiths? Non-denominational and less formal?
2. Will you be writing words/thoughts to share with each other that you would like me to incorporate into the ceremony? Will you be writing your own vows?
3. Do you want to review the ceremony prior to your big day, or do you want it to be a surprise?
4. How would you both like to be referenced in the ceremony (e.g. Mike vs Michael etc.)
5. Do you have an expectation of ceremony length, on average ceremonies are 5-10 minutes?
6. Is there anyone else we will be incorporating into your ceremony? A reading, poem, pet, flower girl/boy, ring bearer, honoring or remembering a loved one?
7. How many attendees will you have? Will I be mic'd up?
8. Will you want me to participate or run the ceremony rehearsal?
9. Do you have a planner or photographer you would like me to connect with before the wedding?
